The Role

The Residential Graduate Assistant plays an important part in school life by playing a part in and supporting two key areas of the School - Sport and Boarding.

Sport

The Residential Graduate Assistant will support the Cross Campus Director of Sport and team in delivering quality, cross campus sports including preparation and maintenance of resources, materials and providing support to staff and pupils. The post holder will assist and coach across the whole age and ability range during timetabled sports sessions and extra-curricular activities including weekend fixtures. When not coaching, the role will also provide support to the Sports team on both the administration and commercial side of the operation.

Boarding

The second element of the role is to provide support to the Houseparents' in the Boarding Houses and to act as the responsible adult in the boarding house when the Houseparent is off duty. The Residential Graduate Assistant will ensure that all members of the boarding house are safe and well whilst on duty, and be proactive in maintaining high standards of pastoral care. When on duty the Residential Graduate Assistant will be the duty supervisor for the boarding staff within their boarding house.
