PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION DETAILS

Registration

United Kingdom - Registration fee £60 (non-refundable). To be sent with Registration Form.

Overseas - Registration Fee £105 (non-refundable). To be sent with Registration Form.

PAYMENT

Fees for each term are to be paid in advance and must be settled no later than the first day of term. By prior agreement only for each term a term's fees may be paid by up to four monthly instalments.

UK pupils' fees will be subject to a £250 deposit (which will be included and invoiced on the first school bill) which will be held and set against the final extras bill at the end of the pupils' school career.

Overseas pupils' will be required to pay **two terms in advance, one being held in credit towards the final term's fees.** Those overseas pupils who only attend for part of the year will be charged on a pro rata basis for the weeks they attend. Overseas pupils' fees will be subject to a further £500 deposit (which will be included and invoiced on the first school bill) which will be held and set against the final extras bill at the end of the pupils' school career.

NB: In the event of the withdrawal of a pupil, notice should be given a term in advance, or in lieu of such a term's fees will be charged.

Weekly Boarders

A weekly boarder is a day pupil who wishes to take advantage of the boarding environment of the school. Such a pupil boards from Monday until the last school duty on Friday or Saturday. They return to school on Monday morning. Sunday night returns are permissible with the agreement of the house master/house mistress but meals will not be provided on Sunday.
